We are very fortunate to have our contract in place and enjoy the benefits and wage increases at a time when some WSD Unions are still at the table and voting for strike action.

Please note that our 2.9 percent wage increase will result in our unions dues increasing by approximately \$ 1.40 per pay period. This is something that CUPE National charges us as percentage of wages.
